HEALTH RULES FOR SWINE

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 14 days prior to check-in is required.
2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI). Animals appearing unhealthy upon arrival may not enter the exhibition grounds. Animals are not to be unloaded until health requirements are checked.
3. An Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR) statement for the animals being exhibited must be included on the fair registration form. (A separate VCPR form is no longer required)
4. No swine species shall be exhibited unless each animal is permanently identified by an official 840 series radio frequency identification (RFID) ear tag and the ear tag number is recorded on the CVI
5. Individual animal ID is required and must be an ISO-compliant 15-digit ear tag (including RFID)
(Herd IDs and ear notch registration are no longer accepted)

Out of State Swine: Animals originating from out of state must comply with the Westmoreland Fair Health Rules and the requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture at

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1. No swine showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show.
 2. All show swine must be individually identified.
 3. All swine must have registration papers to show as purebreds.
 4. Original Animal Breed Registration papers will be checked prior to the show.
 5. Joint ownership considered being as one owner in accordance with registration papers. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 animals in any one class, limited to one entry per group class per exhibitor.
 6. All swine must have a nipple waterer.
 7. All livestock exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding.
 8. No miniature breeds will be accepted for entry.
 9. All "Other Purebred" classes must be registered in the *Recognized Swine Associations for Pork Producing*.
 10. All animals must come into the show ring for their respective class, only then can they be considered in group classes.

The following are additional guidelines for 4-H/FFA entries:

1. Entry fee is to be paid for each Division (Open Class and/or 4-H/FFA) entered.
2. 4-H club or FFA members must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.
3. No breeding swine are permitted across the scales.

ENTRY FEE - \$4.00 per animal

1. Refer to General Rules for Swine as well as the additional 4H & FFA guidelines.
2. All show swine must be individually identified.
3. No exhibitor may show more than two market swine.
4. Weight requirement: 240-290 lbs.
5. Open to purebred and crossbred barrows and gilts.
6. Gilts shown in breeding classes cannot be shown in market classes.
7. Nipple waterer required.
8. Due to weight variances and weight limits, the fair will set the number of weight classes.

DEPARTMENT 108, SECTION E, 4-H & FFA ULTRASOUND CARCASS SWINE

ENTRY FEE - \$4.00 per animal

1. Open to purebred and crossbred barrows and gilts that are entered as a market animal and meet the weight requirements of the market classes. Weight requirement on swine is 240-290 pounds.
2. Animals must be entered in both the Market Class as well as the Carcass Contest. All Market animals may be designated to compete in an Ultrasound carcass contest. The animal must be designated at the time of weigh in.
3. Animals entered in the Ultrasound classes must be entered and shown in the Market Classes.
4. Hogs must meet the minimum back fat standards of the contest, or they will be disqualified.
5. Results to be announced at the close of the Market Show Champion Drive.
6. Carcass results will have no effect on placing in the Market show.
