SECTION A-APIARY PRODUCTS

- Extracted honey to be judged on body, clarity, cleanliness.
- Comb honey to be judged on perfection in filling, uniformity, neatness, and cleanliness.
- Beeswax to be judged on color and clarity.
- Liquid Honey to be in clear jars.
- No names business or farm are to be on the entry.

1. Light comb (3 sections)
2. Dark comb (3 sections)
3. Light Extracted Honey (3 one-pound jars)
4. Amber Extracted Honey (3 one-pound jars)
5. Dark Extracted Honey (3 one-pound jars)
6. Finely Crystallized Honey (3 one-pound jars)
7. Creamed Honey (one 8-ounce jar)
8. Collective exhibit of honey, wax and honey products
9. Poured, tapered candles (2 per exhibit)
10. 2-3 pound unit of beeswax

SECTION B-MAPLE PRODUCTS

- All Names are to be removed from the exhibit to include business or farm name
- Syrup is to be displayed in a clear, one quart container
- Syrup to be judged on flavor, color, density, and clarity.
- Sugar to be judged on flavor, appearance, and texture.
- Syrup to be judged on flavor, color, density, and clarity.
- Sugar to be judged on flavor, appearance, and texture.

CLASS **1st/\$5, 2nd/\$4, 3rd/\$3, 4th/\$2, 5th/\$1**

1. Maple Sugar (8 oz.)
Must be displayed in a clear quart jar with no name identification visible
2. Golden Delicate Maple Syrup
3. Amber Rich Maple Syrup
4. Dark Robust Maple Syrup
5. Very Dark Robust Maple Syrup
