

ENTRIES 101

- **Read the General Rules**
- Take note and follow all rules and guidelines pertaining to the departments that you are entering. This information is located at the beginning of each department.
- **There may not be a class for an item that you wish to enter.**
 - Be sure to use the correct Entry Form.
 - **PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY, or entries may be wrong and/or you may not receive your check in the mail.**
 - Use a separate entry form or sheet of paper **for each family member** entering exhibits.
 - Entry fees may be combined in one check (indicate on the memo line the family members)
 - Example: The Smith Family

Jane Smith	\$2
John Smith	\$3
Sally Smith	\$2
Check Total	\$7
 - Entry forms with fees must be received and postmarked by **August 1, 2023, or they cannot be accepted.**
- **Livestock Entries**
 - Take note of arrival and release times posted in the beginning of the exhibitor guide.
 - Read all health requirements. **VET signed VPCR FORM REQUIRED**
 - If entering an animal in Open Class and 4-H, entry fees must be paid for both Open Class and 4-H.
- **Inside Family Living, 4-H and Agricultural Entries**
 - Exhibits are to arrive **Thursday, August 15th – 4pm-8pm**
 - Exhibits are released: **Sunday, August 25th – 9:00am – 11:00.**
 - It is recommended that you send a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry forms to receive entry tags prior to entry arrival day – this way corrections can be made and the entry arrival day process will go smoothly.
 - Please consider the number of tags being returned to you when affixing postage to the SASE. (More than three exhibitor tags require additional postage.)
 - You may make only **one entry per class** unless otherwise noted.

A Guide to Making Inside Exhibit Entries

Arrive in plenty of time to get to the various buildings to deliver your entries on **Thursday, August 15th, 4 pm -8pm**. If you are picking up your entry tags at the fair's Entry Office on Thursday, more time will be needed. The buildings will be closed promptly at 8 pm to prepare for judging on Friday. The following is a general guideline as to where to take your entries when you arrive at the fairgrounds. Please refer to the map of the fairgrounds inside this book.

4-H Door A: Benefit Auction Items, Photography, Foods and Nutrition, Baked Goods, Nutrition Posters, and Club Scrapbooks.

4-H Door B: Vegetables

4-H Door C: Bicycling, Conservation, Electricity, Entomology, Fishing, Flowers, Forestry, Geology, Rockets, Wildlife, Woodworking, Robotics, LEGOs and Club Exhibits.

4-H Door D: Arts & Crafts, Clothing, Cloverbuds, Baby Sitting, First Aid, Jewelry, Scrapbooking and Theatre Arts.

Family Living Door A: Clothing, Foods, and Art.

Family Living Door B: Photography

Family Living Door C: Quilts, Afghans, Yarnwork, Needlework and Handicrafts.

Agricultural Door A: Fruits & Nuts, Flowers, and Apiary.

Agricultural Door B: Vegetables, Hay, and Grain.

Commercial 2 Door O: Scarecrows
